2025 Survey Results - Parents

- Parents are OK with bimonthly meetings on Tuesday at 6PM; if we could have childcare that would help!
- Parents want to hear from PTO on Dojo and in a monthly enewsletter
- Parents want to contribute by:
 - Volunteering at events (91.7% of respondents)
 - Helping with fundraising (41% of respondents)
- AND, you want to hear about things early and often!

Takeaways: Big Picture for 2025 -2026

Focus on overlapping priorities first

- Creating classroom directories
- Support the Room Parent Program
- Plan Playground Meetups to connect parents across grade levels

Funding smaller needs sooner

- Ex. new basketball goals, new equipment for outside spaces
- Ex. funding teacher wishlists

Planning/Completing Big Picture Projects

- Finalizing quote and moving forward with Sun Shade project from 2024-2025
- Create a plan for redeveloping front area of school to serve students/community
