Mulch installation, log benches (X8), picnic tables (X6) for front area - \$13,500

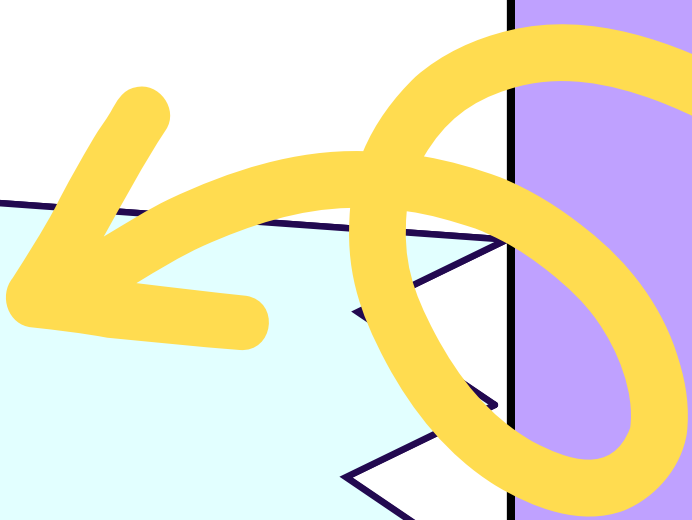
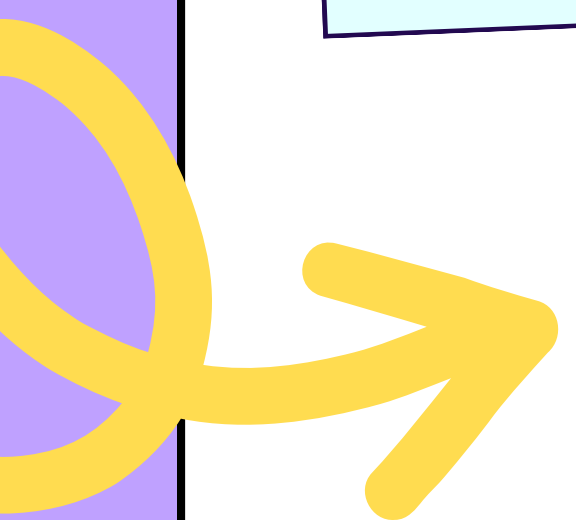
Rewards for School Store (where students shop with Dojo points!) - \$2300

all of this spending on TRES!

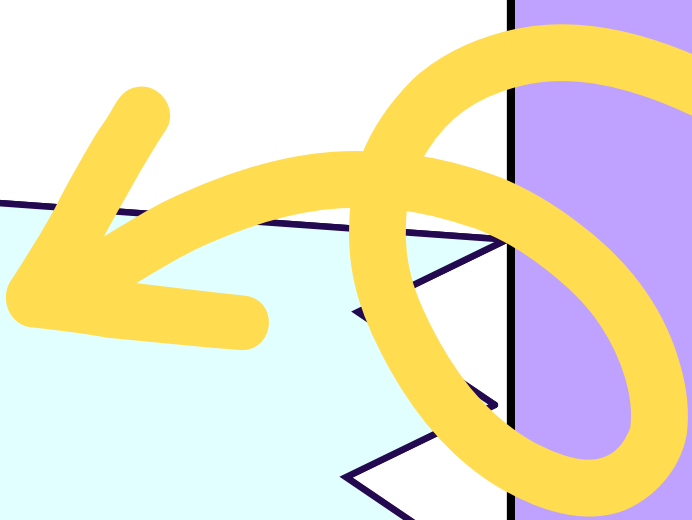

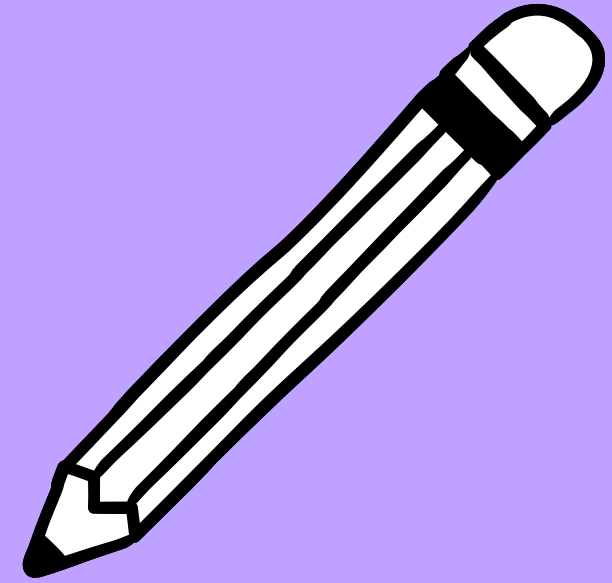

“I think new furniture and improved organization in the grade-level pods could make a huge difference. As our school continues to grow, gifted teachers and EIP teachers are quickly losing the dedicated spaces we have available to provide services. It’s a wonderful problem to have so many students and families wanting to be part of our school, but with our growing gifted population, it can be challenging to figure out where we can pull students for services and where we can teach our groups. Having comfortable, functional furniture and well-organized pods could help us make better use of the spaces we do have and create flexible learning environments for small groups and specialized instruction.”
